Accounts

Just a reminder that annual accounts will be due from the end of December month i.e. 31st December. They are to be submitted to the Div/Dis Com by the 31st Jan. So get that Calculator out and start pressing those buttons!

What do I need to submit:-

For a review or examination to take place, you need to give the independent reviewer or examiner your annual accounts statement with your statement of assets and liabilities, and all supporting documents. This could include:

- Budget for the year
- Cash account pages
- Bank statements
 - Paying in slips
- Cheque book stubs
 - Invoices
 - Receipts
- Details of any Gift Aid income. Do not share any names or addresses
 - Attendance registers
 - Subscription records, like your membership records
- Proof of authorisation, by another signatory, for transactions made without dual

authorisation
