Walking is an easy way to take girls on an adventure outside the unit meeting place - this scheme will help you make the most of it! After you've completed the Girlguiding Walking Scheme Level 1, you will be able to plan routes and navigate walks with girls in lowland country, including tracks and paths, fields, woods and lanes.

Let's Get started. What do I need to do?

- Attend a Girlguiding Level 1 training course
- Complete the clauses for the modules of Level 1
- Keep a log book of walks you have completed in the UK for Level 1 this must be at least six walks, one of which must be of 6km or more in distance
- Be assessed while you plan and lead a walk in lowland country
