

#### Work at Gorwelion

Thank you to those who gave up their time to support the January working weekends. You worked hard and long hours which is much appreciated.

What have we achieved?

- Flat: repainted and windowsills tiled.
- Kitchen: New floor laid, tiles cleaned, ceiling pained, new tables, fridge and storage.
- Main room: repainted
- Leaders room: repainted
- Ongoing maintenance to ensure we care for Gorwelion's future.

#### What needs doing next?

- Little site shelter: needs another coat of paint outside (materials are there).
- House: back end of house needs painting (materials are there).
- Trees that have been chopped: wood needs chopping further and be moved to the wood shed.
- Ferns that have been cut back need to be burnt and the area cleaned.
- Gutters and drains of house need cleaning.
- Camp fire circle to be constructed.
- Outdoor shelter has a floor but needs sealing.
- Area around garage to be cleared and concreted so a retaining wall can be built.
- Woodland walk project to be developed.

Work at Gorwelion will always be ongoing but we have received positive feedback from those using the facility and we are grateful for any support offered by volunteers.

#### Safe space training

All members are responsible for ensuring that they are compliant with safe space. Please look at your record on Go - this will inform you when you need to renew. You will also receive at least 2 emails from CHQ which are automatically generated reminding you at 6 months and 3 months.

If your safe space is it is not completed, then CHQ will take you off Go and you will not be able to rejoin Guiding for up to 3 years. Please advise either myself or inform CHQ once you have received your email if there are any exceptional circumstances.

Any member who is a leader or assistant leader will be required to do safe space level 3 in 2024 so please book ahead and carry out the training - there will be a significant demand next year. This is available online through the learning portal. You can participate in the webinar training from any country and region.
